

ENVER PASHA IS FOUND.

Discovered in Trans-Caucasia, He
Must Face Trial.

WASHINGTON, May 23.—Enver Pasha, former Minister of War of the Ottoman Empire, has been discovered among the Tartars of Trans-Caucasia, according to advices received today through official channels.

Enver Pasha is wanted by the allied authorities and by the Turkish Government on charges ranging from theft to wholesale murder. When he fled from Constantinople it was reported that he carried a large part of the cash of the Turkish Empire, possibly \$25,000,000.

Enver Pasha is also accused of having directed the wholesale massacre of Armenians, Syrians, and Greeks during the war.
